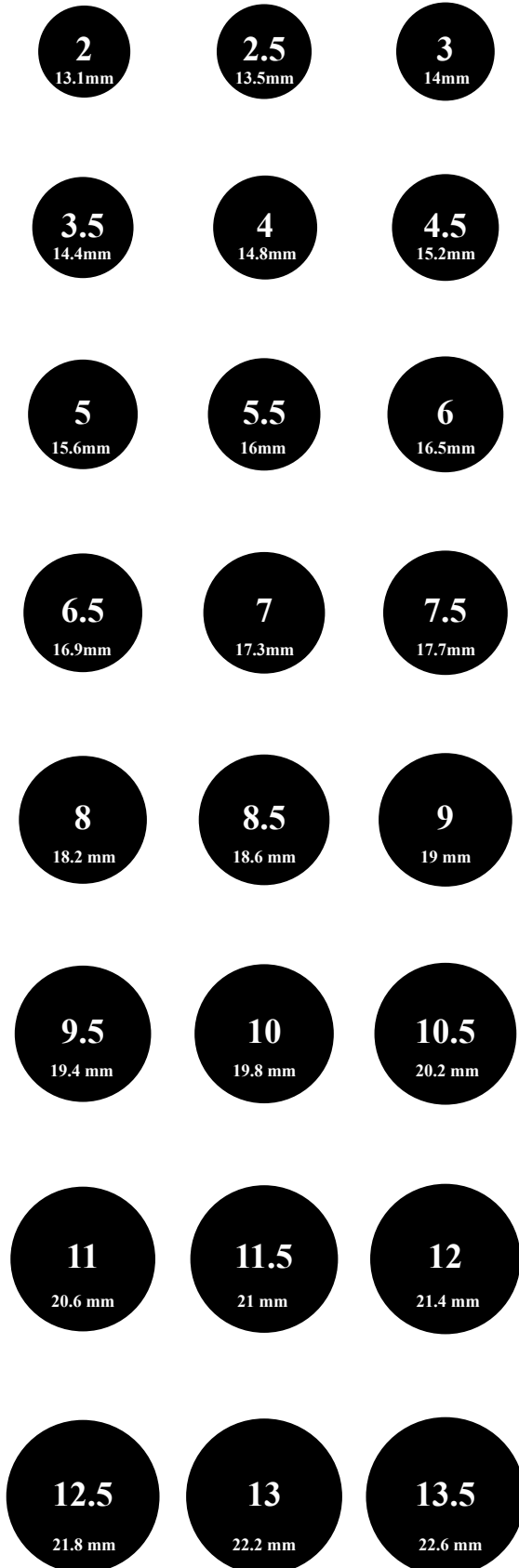


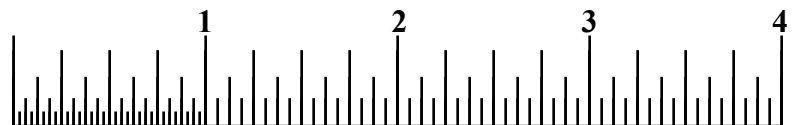


# How To Determine Your Ring Size



To figure out your ring size, you'll need a ring which fits well & this printable guide.

1. Print this guide. Make sure that scaling is set to 100%. Double check that it printed correctly by comparing the ruler below with one you have.
2. Find the circle to the left which matches the **inside** of your ring the closest. The number inside the circle indicates the ring size that you wear. The smaller number shows the diameter, in millimeters.
3. If your ring falls between sizes, I suggest sizing up.
3. Be mindful of the band width. A wider ring band will often make a ring fit more snug. If the band is thicker than 6mm, you may want to consider sizing up.
