



How To Determine Your Ring Size



To figure out your ring size, you'll need a ring which fits well & this printable guide.

- 1. Print this guide. Make sure that scaling is set to 100%. Double check that it printed correctly by comparing the ruler below with one you have.
- 2. Find the circle to the left which matches the **inside** of your ring the closest. The number inside the circle indicates the ring size that you wear. The smaller number shows the diameter, in millimeters.
- 3. If your ring falls between sizes, I suggest sizing up.
- 3. Be mindful of the band width. A wider ring band will often make a ring fit more snug. If the band is thicker than 6mm, you may want to consider sizing up.
